A HABITAT FOR JET THE GERBIL*

GRADE RANGE: K-3

TIME: 45 MINUTES

MATERIALS:

- O THE LEGEND OF JET THE GERBIL BY MICHAEL KELLER
- O LARGE PAPER OR BOARD FOR WRITING
- O OPTIONAL:
 - · COPIES OF HABITAT WORKSHEET
 - · Scissors
 - · GLUE

OVERVIEW:

In this lesson, students will gather information from reading <u>The Legend of Jet the Gerbil</u>, then investigate and explore how the basic needs of an animal are provided in their habitat, using organisms commonly kept in homes as pets. Students will compare and contrast these needs to develop an understanding of the common basic needs of living organisms.

VOCABULARY:

HABITAT: THE NATURAL HOME OF A PLANT OR AN ANIMAL

RODENT: A TYPE OF FOUR-LEGGED, GNAWING MAMMAL WITH TEETH THAT CONSTANTLY GROW

INTRODUCTION

READ THE LEGEND OF JET THE GERBIL.

JET WAS A VERY SPECIAL GERBIL AND MICHAEL WORKED HARD TO GIVE HIM EVERYTHING HE NEEDED TO BE HAPPY AND HEALTHY. NORMALLY, GERBILS IN THE WILD LIVE OUTSIDE IN THEIR HABITAT: THEIR NATURAL HOME. IT HAS EVERYTHING THEY NEED TO BE HAPPY AND HEALTHY. WHAT DO YOU NEED IN YOUR 'HABITAT' TO STAY HAPPY AND HEALTHY?

ON A LARGE PAPER OR BOARD, CREATE A LIST OF WHAT PEOPLE NEED IN THEIR 'HABITAT', LEAVING ROOM FOR A LIST ABOUT JET THE GERBIL NEXT TO IT. TAKE TIME TO POINT OUT PHYSICAL NEEDS, EMOTIONAL NEEDS AND CONTRAST THEM WITH 'WANTS'.

HOW WOULD YOU FEEL IF YOU DIDN'T HAVE SOME OF THESE THINGS IN YOUR 'HABITAT'?

WHAT DID MICHAEL PROVIDE FOR JET TO STAY HAPPY AND HEALTHY?

HELP STUDENTS REVIEW THE BOOK AS NEEDED TO FIND SOME ANSWERS.

START A SECOND COLUMN ON THE LARGE PAPER/BOARD FOR JET THE GERBIL'S HABITAT.

INCLUDED IN THE MAIN TEXT: GLASS TANK, EXERCISE WHEEL, SOFT BEDDING, GERBIL HOUSE;

STUDENTS MIGHT ALSO POINT OUT 'MEDICAL CARE' FROM MICHAEL'S DAD.

WHAT FOODS DO YOU NEED IN YOUR HABITAT?

ADD TO 'PEOPLE' LIST, AS APPROPRIATE.

WHAT DID JET EAT?

HELP STUDENTS REVIEW THE BOOK, IF NEEDED, AND ADD TO THE 'JET THE GERBIL' LIST SOME STUDENTS MAY HAVE GERBILS OR RELATED ANIMALS AS PETS AND CAN SUGGEST APPROPRIATE FOODS.

READ SELECTED PORTIONS OF THE 'GERBIL FACTS TO CHEW ON' AT THE END OF THE LEGEND OF JET THE GERBIL TO FIND MORE INFORMATION ABOUT WHAT GERBILS EAT IN THE WILD AND AS PETS.

AT SOME POINT, A STUDENT MIGHT IDENTIFY THE PAPER TOWEL TUBE. EXPLAIN THAT THE TUBE WASN'T ACTUALLY FOOD, BUT THAT HE CHEWED ON IT TO KEEP HIS TEETH HEALTHY.

GERBILS ARE IN A GROUP OF ANIMALS CALLED **RODENTS** THAT HAVE TEETH THAT NEVER STOP GROWING. They need to chew a lot to wear down their teeth. Other types of rodents are mice, rats, squirrels, hamsters, guinea pigs and even porcupines! What do you need to keep your teeth healthy?

ADD TO LISTS AS APPROPRIATE

APPLICATION

This is a great list! How would you feel if you were Jet and didn't have all of these in your habitat?

KEEPING A PET IS A BIG RESPONSIBILITY BECAUSE YOU NEED TO CREATE A HABITAT THAT IS JUST RIGHT FOR YOUR PET TO KEEP THEM HAPPY AND HEALTHY. LET'S CREATE A HABITAT FOR JET THE GERBIL!

Younger students: Complete the following worksheet page to create a habitat for Jet the Gerbil.

OLDER STUDENTS: DRAW A PICTURE OF A HABITAT FOR JET THE GERBIL

CONCLUSION

THESE WOULD BE GREAT HABITATS FOR JET. IS THERE ANOTHER KIND OF PET THAT MIGHT ALSO LIKE THIS HABITAT?

STUDENTS CAN BE PROMPTED BY REMINDING THEM ABOUT RODENTS.

Would this be a good habitat for a fish? For a dog? No! Different living things need different habitats. Discuss similarities and differences between their habitats and gerbil habitats, between what they need and what gerbils need, or between habitats for different animals.

CONCEPTS TO HIGHLIGHT:

- O EATING ONLY PLANTS, EAT MEAT (OR BUGS, LIKE GERBILS!) OR BOTH,
- LIVING IN DIFFERENT SHELTERS
- O ALL LIVING THINGS NEED WATER TO SURVIVE

EXTENSIONS:

- O RESEARCH AND DESIGN HABITATS FOR DIFFERENT KINDS OF PETS
- O DESIGN AND BUILD A HABITAT FOR A NEW OR EXISTING CLASS PET (MAYBE A GERBIL!).
- O BUILD MODELS OF GERBIL HABITATS OUT OF SHOEBOXES: SHREDDED PAPER BEDDING, PAPER TOWEL TUBES, TISSUE BOXES, EMPTY TRAVEL—SIZE SOAP BOTTLES FOR WATER BOTTLES, PENCIL SHAVINGS OR GRAVEL TO REPRESENT FOOD.
- O BRING IN PICTURES OF 'HABITATS' THEY HAVE CREATED FOR THEIR OWN PETS AT HOME. HOUSEPLANTS ARE PETS, TOO!
